



TNRPCV 10-year Anniversary Survey Results

Survey Respondents


- 41 total responses

- Almost exclusively from Nashville and middle Tennessee




Level of Engagement with TNRPCV in recent past




Obstacles to participating in TNRPCV events




What is TNRPCV doing well?






How can TNRPCV improve?



Feedback about TNRPCV activities








